They are mobile with the assistance of a cane, walker or wheelchair.

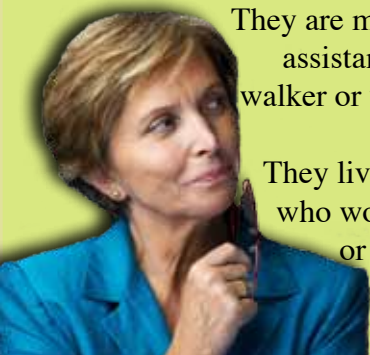
They live with someone who works during the day or is frequently away from home.
